### KEEP PILTOWN TIDY

On Tuesday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 72 hanging baskets containing an assortment of summer bedding plants, were put on the flower stands around the village. The winter/spring flowering plants already in the baskets were removed to be recycled. Bulbs such as daffodils and tulips were salvaged for use next year and the remaining plants went for composting.

The Group are busy on Wednesday evenings cutting grass and tidying areas around the village. The judges from the Tidy Towns will be along this month so it is important to have everything good and tidy. Bedding plants were planted in the tubs at Foyles garage and a lot of bedding plants were planted in the long beds along the road at Falvey's garage. Jason Power from the CE scheme can be seen daily collecting rubbish and emptying bins along the main street and up to the Community centre.

Plans are in place to erect two visitor information boards at either end of the village to inform visitors and locals of the many interesting areas of historical significance around the village such as Hatchets well, Kildalton College, formally Bessborough house and many more areas of interest.

In the top Rectors field, opposite Kildalton close, the steep bank was cleared of briars and undergrowth recently. The plan there is to plant ground cover shrubs and some trees.

The grant application system is now open. All applications must be made on line. via [www.susi.ie](http://www.susi.ie) SUSI is the national awarding authority responsible for financial support to eligible students in approved full time further and higher education courses across Ireland. Irish students studying in the UK and other EU Countries may also qualify for limited support. Only Government funded Colleges are eligible. Students would have ticked the SUSI box when filling out their CAO form. The priority closing date is July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025 where a fast decision on your application will be made before the main applications are submitted.
