DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Divine Mercy Sunday was officially established as a Feastday by Pope John Paul II in 2000 at the canonization of St. Faustina (Maria Faustina Kowalska) and is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter. The Lord expressed His will with regard to this feast in His very first revelation to St. Faustina in the 1930's. Nevertheless, Divine Mercy Sunday is not a feast based solely on St. Faustina's revelations. It is not primarily about St. Faustina – nor is it altogether a new feast. The second Sunday of Easter was already a solemnity as the Octave Day of Easter. The title "Divine Mercy Sunday" does however, highlight the meaning of the day and there are two special graces available on Divine Mercy Sunday, a Special Plenary Indulgence and the Extraordinary Grace.
