KILKENNY COMMUNITY COMPOSTING TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR SPRING & SUMMER 2023

Kilkenny Leader Partnership in conjunction with the Southeast Energy Agency invite you to join us for an action packed training programme to teach people how to reduce food waste and compost both at home and within your community. Training consists of 1 evening in-person, 3 evening on-line classroom sessions and 1 half-day hands on workshop

(weekend) to gain the knowledge required to prevent food waste using a variety of different composting systems. Training is free but volunteers are expected to attend all training courses to avail of the funding and technical assistance being offered by Kilkenny County Council to develop Tidy Town and community composting projects once the training has been completed. Booking is essential as places are limited and are confined to 3-6 volunteers per community for 15 communities in total within County Kilkenny only. Training sessions are being offered in Thomastown, Freshford and Piltown. Sessions will take place in Piltown on June 6th, 13th, 20th, 24th and 27th.
