PARISH COMMUNITY CENTRE

- The extensive library is open daily and is stocked with lots of good books to borrow. Crime, autobiographies, science, history, children's and all your favourite author's books are on the shelves. Donations of books in good condition are always gratefully accepted.
- Bowls, mixed, take place on Monday & Thursdays from 10am to 1pm.
- Iverk show meetings are held monthly and sub-committee meetings of the show such as cattle, horses, crafts etc are held weekly coming up to show day.
- Art classes are held every Tuesdays from 10am to 1pm.
- The popular and successful karate club are in the hall on Monday and Wednesday evenings, 5.30 to 8pm.
- Music enthusiasts are accommodated well with piano and music lessons on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 3pm to 9pm.
- Knitting from 10am to 1pm on Mondays

- Irish dancing happens there on Tuesdays from 5 to 7pm.
- Table tennis on Mondays from 8.30pm to 10 and again on Thursdays from 7pm to 10.
- Pilates on Tuesdays happen from 7.30pm to 8.30pm.
- To get fit, Robert Power does circuit training on Tuesdays from 7 to 8pm, and chairrobics happen on Wednesdays from 11am to 12.
- Other clubs which meet in the Community centre on a seasonal basis include the over 60s club; baking classes; craft classes and computer classes.
- The church choir practice there regularly and meetings of the pastoral council, eucharistic ministers, church readers etc are held there.
- The food cloud, a registered charity which works with food businesses nationwide and which have surplus food, deliver food to the community centre monthly where it is distributed to needy families in the parish.
- The community centre also caters for refreshments after funerals
- A state-of-the-art snooker club operates in dedicated rooms at the rear of the centre for club members.
- The hard surface basketball court in front of the community centre is used well by the community especially on summer evenings by students on holidays.
- There is always a friendly cup of tea or coffee on offer after club activities have finished.
