### ST. FRANCIS PAUPERS CEMETERY, CARRICK-ON-SUIR

At this time of year when we all attend the cemeteries to remember our loved ones in prayer, your thoughts and prayers are asked for all those who are buried in St. Francis Paupers Cemetery in Carrick-on-Suir.

The Paupers Cemetery was used for burials from the town, surrounding parishes, the local workhouse and fever hospital during the second half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and into the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Men, women, and children from Piltown, Templeorum and Owning, who were referred to at the time as Paupers, are also interred there. No burial records exist due mainly to the fire which gutted the workhouse in 1922. In any event, most of the bodies interred there would have had no one to claim them at their death. If you are passing by during the summer months please drop in and spend a moment in prayer to remember those who are buried there.
