SR. ANTHONY (ANN) NOLAN RIP – MONTH'S MIND



Sr. Anthony (Ann) Nolan grew up in Rathmines, Dublin as a daughter of Ann Nolan (nee Duggan) of Owning but made summer holiday visits to Castletown and Owning. She took interest in the Sisters of St. Joseph (of the Apparition) in Northern Ireland where she first entered their boarding school and later joined the congregation. At 17 she went to Marseilles to commence her noviciate and after finishing her studies in Oxford University, she professed her final vows in Manchester. She was then sent to the Holy Land where she spent the rest of her religious life as a Teacher, Superior and Provincial for over 60 years in such places as Jerusalem, Jaffa, Ramleh and Nazareth. She worked for God's glory helping the poor and broken families enabled by her fluency in French and Arabic. She loved to come back to Ireland every two years to visit her family and to make a retreat to Knock with Owning holding special memories of her childhood. Her final months were spent in the care of her sisters at Notre Dame De Grace, Jerusalem where she was much remembered for her lovely smile, tender heart and generosity to all. Sr. Anthony passed to her eternal rest on 27th July, 2023 and was buried on Mount Zion on 31st July, 2023. May she Rest in Peace.
