Artist Inseun Kim, who has experience teaching fine art in Korea and also works as a tutor with STAG (Clonmel), will be our teacher. She says applying colour to silk can be regarded as a kind of art therapy based on the depth of colour created by the proper harmony of water and dyes and the tranquillity brought by the harmony of the two materials. The art classes form part of the library's Bealtine programme and the finished works will be displayed in the library during the last week of May.
