KEEP PILTOWN TIDY

Members of Keep Piltown Tidy have been busy over the last 2 weeks planting 2 areas in the village. Inside the boundary field at the Rectory has been planted with 350 hardy laurel hedging plants. The area was cleared beforehand of bramble and rubbish. The hedge will grow to a half meter over the wall and then clipped. Parts of the wall especially near the bus shelter will be repaired shortly. The other area which was planted is across the road at the back gate to Kildalton College. A hymar cleared and levelled the site which is at 2 levels and goes down to the Pil River. 82 different variety plants and trees were planted on Saturday, April 20th. The plants included Guelder rose, hawthorn, hazel, holly, oak, Scots pine, silver birch, crab apple alder, spindle, and cherry. This planted area is an excellent place for biodiversity and will be managed accordingly.

Hatchet's well has been cleared of bramble and weeds and the path from the road to the well is now clear for people to visit the well. The wall along the path will be repaired over the next few months.

The application for the 2024 Tidy Town Competition will be submitted in the next few weeks. New members to Keep Piltown Tidy are especially welcome.
