The second meeting of the Men's Shed took place on the 24th of September in the Iverk show meeting room. 10 people attended along with Michael Cass from

Dungarvan Men's Shed. Michael outlined details on getting the Men's Shed off the ground as constitution, regards its compliance with the Charities regulator and Revenue. Activities in the shed should ideally be 80% of a social nature and 20% used to develop new skills such as woodturning, making bird boxes etc. It is hoped to have as many as possible members different skill sets.

Accounts are returned annually, and the shed should be non-religious and non-political to be a success. Funding of the shed will be from grants, donations, fund raising activities and membership fees.


