ADVENT

Sunday, December 1st marks the first Sunday of Advent. The season of Advent is dedicated to reflective preparation for the arrival, "advent" Jesus Christ's Nativity at Christmas time. This important event on the church calendar focuses on a different theme each week - Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. Christians all denominations backgrounds celebrate Advent in different ways but all focus on the anticipation of waiting for the arrival of Jesus. The lighting of the candles on the Advent Wreath is a common practice. Each candle represents one of the four weeks of Advent. A new candle is lit on each Sunday.

Advent is seen as a time of giving and helping others but is also a time for spiritual reflection and prayer. Prayer is a beautiful way to help cut away from distractions of the season in preparation for the joy and hope of Christ's birth.

Advent Prayer

This Advent, Lord, come to the Manger of my heart. Fill me with Your presence from the very start.

As I prepare for the holidays and gifts to be given, remind me of the gift You gave when You sent Your Son from Heaven.
