ADVENT

This weekend marks the second Sunday of Advent in 2024 (Dec 8th). The theme of Advent's second Sunday is the peace that Christ brought to mankind with His birth and incarnation.

This candle reminds us that the angels declared "peace on earth" at the birth of Jesus. Jesus offers us inner peace and peace with others. We can know and experience peace today only through the life of Jesus Christ.

- "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." (*Luke 2:14*)
- "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel' (which means 'God with us')." (Matthew 1:23)

Prayer for PEACE

Lord, in a season when every heart should be happy and light, many of us are struggling with the heaviness of life - burdens that steal the joy right out of our stockings. Tragedy arrives as innocent victims suffer, and an inner voice whispers, "Be afraid!" We need your peace, Jesus.
