2025 JUBILEE YEAR



Pope Francis invites us to rediscover the centrality of prayer in our personal and community life in this the holy year as “Pilgrims in Hope” — which is the motto of the Jubilee of 2025. The jubilee logo, designed by Italian artist Giacomo Traversari, shows four stylized figures, representing all of humanity coming from the four corners of the earth. They embrace each other to indicate the solidarity and fraternity which should unite all peoples. The rough waves under the figures symbolize the fact that life’s pilgrimage does not always go smoothly in calm waters. The anchor is a symbol of hope. The dynamic cross of Christ bends down towards humanity, not leaving us all alone, but stretching

out to us to offer the certainty of its presence and the security of hope. A hymn, “Pilgrims of Hope,” by Pierangelo Sequeri with music by Francesco Meneghello, has also been written for the jubilee year.

Throughout the year, individual jubilees are scheduled and the entire calendar of jubilee celebrations is available on the Jubilee website.
