PILTOWN GAA CLUB

Piltown GAA Club recently presented €500 from their Allstar15 draw to the Irish Red Cross to support the work they do in the local area. The Irish Red Cross, Portlaw Branch, established in 2007, operates two Cardiac First Response Groups which respond to certain life threatening conditions as tasked by the National Ambulance Service on a 24/7 basis. The groups cover areas around Portlaw and Kill and have recently expanded to a wider area in South Kilkenny, encompassing Piltown, Fiddown, Owing, Templeorum, Mooncoin and Carrigeen within a 10km radius from the centre of Portlaw. 18 responders volunteer to assist with life threatening conditions such as choking, stroke, chest pain and cardiac arrest in their communities until the arrival of the National Ambulance Service. The groups maintain a number of defibrillators, some of them as public access AEDs which can be used by anyone in case of emergencies. Skills are kept fresh and current by training regularly with the unit which also provides medical cover at events with two ambulances, a youth group as well as community supports in various forms.
