1. Install new footpaths to complete the pedestrian link on Main Street from the Campus service station to the junction with Tybroughan Road.

2. Provision of 3 raised pedestrian crossings on Main Street at Belline Way, Banagher Place and the credit union.
3. Junction treatment along the route to improve pedestrian safety.
4. Traffic calming ramp on the approaches to the village.
5. Provision of drainage as required.
