### MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY

In 1945, Pope Pius XII solidified May as a Marian month after establishing the feast of the Queenship of Mary.

A traditional devotion during Mary's month is the May crowning. Children crown a statue of Mary with flowers, usually roses, symbolizing Mary's role as queen of heaven and earth. This is one way we can demonstrate our honour of the Blessed Mother. But there are many other ways we can show our devotion to Mary: praying the Rosary, wearing the Miraculous Medal or Scapular, attending Mass on the first Saturday of the month. This month, consider some ways you can incorporate a special Marian devotion into your life.
