### SPRINGBOARD +

Springboard+ is a Government initiative  
offering free and heavily subsidised  
courses at certificate, degree, and  
master's level leading to qualifications in  
areas where there are employment  
opportunities in the economy. These

areas include ICT, engineering, green skills, manufacturing and construction, among many others.

There are 249 courses available under Springboard+ 2025, the majority of which are flexible and part-time.

Springboard+ is co-funded by the Government of Ireland, via the National Training Fund, and the European Union.

You can apply for Springboard+ if you are:

- ☐ Unemployed
- ☐ Employed
- ☐ A recent graduate
- ☐ Returning to education or work after being a carer or homemaker
- ☐ Updating your ICT skills

You must:

- ☐ Be living in Ireland
- ☐ Have a PPSN number
- ☐ Meet the residency requirements
- ☐ Meet other eligibility criteria for EU and non-EU applicants

To apply for a Springboard+ course, you choose the course you are interested in on the Springboard+ website and apply online.

## SUSI GRANTS 2025/26

The grant application system is now open. All applications must be made online via [www.susi.ie](http://www.susi.ie). SUSI is the national awarding authority responsible for financial support to eligible students in approved full time further and higher education courses across Ireland. Irish students studying in the UK and other EU Countries may also qualify for limited support. Only Government funded Colleges are eligible. Students would have ticked the SUSI box when filling out their CAO form. The priority closing date is July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025 where a fast decision on your application will be made before the main applications are submitted.
