

SUSI GRANTS 2025/26

The grant application system is now open. All applications must be made on line. via www.susi.ie SUSI is the national authority responsible for awarding financial support to eligible students in approved full time further and higher education courses across Ireland. Irish students studying in the UK and other EU Countries may also qualify for limited support. Only Government funded Colleges are eligible. Students would have ticked the SUSI box when filling out their CAO form. The priority closing date is July 10th, 2025 where a fast decision on your application will be made before the main applications are submitted.
