

#### MEDJUGORJE 2025

Five Templeorum parishioners were part of a group of forty-one people who travelled to Medjugorje on Wed. June 18<sup>th</sup> for a week.

Medjugorje is in southern Bosnia and Herzegovina and has a population of 4,000 people mainly of Croatian ethnicity and Catholic religion. The parish of Medjugorje was founded in 1892 under the protection of St. James, the protector of pilgrims.

The town became famous on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 1981, when six young people claimed to have seen the Blessed Virgin Mary. Since this date, the Virgin Mary has continued to appear daily for 44 years. Each evening, pilgrims gather at apparition time for a few minutes at 5:40pm in winter and 6:40pm in the summer to receive the blessing of our Lady. Pope Francis formalized Our Lady of Medjugorje on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

The group of forty-one people participated in Mass daily in English. А Corpus Christi procession was held on June 19<sup>th</sup> through the streets of Medjugorje where thousands of people participated, mainly young people. On Friday, June 20th, the group climbed Apparition hill, praying the rosary, where Our Lady 1<sup>st</sup> appeared in 1981.

The group visited the Cennacolo Community on the outskirts of Medjugorje during the week. The Community consists of people who were addicted to drugs, alcohol and other addictions and come to the centre and stay there for up to 3 years to be healed without the use of medicine.

The" Blue Cross" was visited on Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>, the site where many Apparitions of our Lady took place, it is located at the base of Apparition hill. The convent of Miletina was visited during the week also. It is home to Franciscan nuns and the group celebrated Mass there. The nuns produce all the Communion hosts for the churches in Medjugorje.

The entire week was enjoyed by all with many of the people in the group on a return journey to Medjugorje. The weather was very warm throughout the week with temperatures reaching 39 degrees.
