

(including other donations) to purchase essential goods to take with her to the poorest of the poor in Delhi. Josephine will give a full report of her trip on her return.


TEMPLEORUM VILLAGE **IMPROVEMENT SCHEME**

with donations gratefully accepted in aid of Owning House. Do come along for what promises to be a Great afternoon. All are Welcome.






TRIP TO KNOCK
