
















#### THE SEASON OF ADVENT

Advent begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas and lasts until Christmas Eve, marking the start of the Liturgical year in many Christian traditions. Each week focuses on a different theme, traditionally hope, peace, joy and love.

- **Hope:** Anticipating the fulfilment of God's promises.
- **Peace:** Reflecting on the peace that Christ brings.
- **Joy:** Celebrating the joy of Christ's coming.
- Love: Emphasizing love for God and one another.

The lighting of candles on the Advent wreath symbolises the growing light of Christ in the world. The wreath is traditionally a circular arrangement of evergreen branches with four candles, one for each week of Advent.

Advent is a meaningful season that encourages Christians to prepare their hearts for the celebration of Christmas while also looking forward to Christ's return. It is a time of reflection, anticipation and spiritual renewal, inviting believers to deepen their faith and commitment to living out the teachings of Jesus in their daily lives.
